



The Contractor will be required to maintain these temporary barricades/fencing so that the on-site students and staff are kept outside the construction areas and safe during and after construction hours.

- 1. Hazardous materials (lead paint and asbestos) abatement.
- 2. Removal of existing relocatable classroom building and relocatable toilet building.
- 3. Demolition of existing parking lot, concrete walkways and other related site demolition as indicated in plans.
- 4. Relocation of existing portable storage sheds and metal storage container.
- 5. Installation of new underground and overhead utilities and modifications to existing utilities.
- 6. Construction of new building pad and installation of new concrete deep foundation (footings, grade beams and piles) in preparation for 72'x40' modular building installation (modular building fabrication and installation is by separate contract).
- 7. Construction of relocatable building pads, wood foundations, skirting and relocation of 2-relocatable buildings and utility connections of same.
- 8. Fabrication and construction of new metal ramps, stairs and landings.
- 9. Installation of new parking lot, concrete walkways, gates and fencing.
- 10. Installation of new subgrade, drainage and walkways in preparation for installation of

new rubber playground surfacing system and new play apparatus equipment (rubber play surface system and apparatus components will be completed by Owner under separate contract).

- Connection of existing and new relocatable classroom/toilet building to utilities. (construction and installation of new relocatable classroom and toilet buildings will be completed by SJCOE under separate contract)

F. Discussion Items:

- 1. **Limited Scope**: The current scope to be included with this bid only includes the work as described above. The Building P6 classroom building, installation of rubber playground surfacing system and installation of the new play apparatus equipment will be completed by SJCOE under separate contract.
- 2. **Prevailing Wage and Certified Payroll Requirements:** This project is a "Public Works" project and the Contractor, and their subcontractors are required to pay prevailing wage for all workers on the Project and to conform with "Prevailing Wage Laws". See the General Conditions for more detailed information.
- 3. CSLB Licensed Contractor and Subcontractors: The Contractor and all subcontractors will be required to have the appropriate, current California Contractors license as issued by the Contractors State License Board for the trade they represent and the work scope they are responsible for. - 4. Listing Subcontractors: Per the Instructions to Bidders, all subcontractors, of any tier, who's contract dollar amount exceeds 0.5% (1/2 of 1%) of the bidder's total bid amount must be listed by the Bidder on the Designation of Subcontractors form and submitted as a part of the bid submittal package. Additional information regarding this can be found in the Designation of Subcontractors form. Failure to properly list subcontractors on the Designation of Subcontractors form may result in the bid being disqualified and determined non-responsive.
