Procedures:

Each team of two will pick up its essay testing box in the WPC Foyer and deliver to either Education Building Rooms 206 or 208 – there is a box for each room. The first hour is for Scholastic students only, and they have been divided between the two rooms. There is a roster in each box of the students who should be in your room. **Check them off the room roster**. The students should also have their essay room on their name tag. Essays begin at 8:30 for Scholastic, 9:50 for Honors, and 11:00 for the Varsity testing. Instructions to be read to students will also be in the box along with all other needed supplies. Directions should be read to students before starting the 50-minute writing period. However, once the essay prompts are turned over, the writing period must begin. There is no longer an extra 5 minutes to read and select a prompt. **Essay packets for alternates will be available to coaches in the WPC foyer after the last morning break.**
