- Please note that there are 18 C division teams and 22 B division teams competing. The C teams are divided evenly between C1 and C2 sections—9 teams each. The B division teams are not with 10 teams in the B1 section and 12 in the B2. Please have your event managers plan accordingly.
- In Picture This C and in Pentathlon B, teams from the same school must sign up for consecutive time slots.
- A concession stand will be available in the chemistry building foyer again this year. Event managers will receive a ticket worth up to \$5 there.
