

Forensics C
Science Olympiad 2010

1. The event manager will go by the rules given in the National Coach's C Division Manual.
2. Water testing has been added to the event this year. Students will be asked to perform 5 water tests at the regional competition. All water testing materials will be supplied and if needed, instructions will be provided.
3. Under Crime Scene Physical Evidence, students will be tested on any **two** of the following four areas—DNA, Entomology, Tracks and Soil, or Blood.
4. The event manager will score teams in accordance with the percentages written in the rules. The most heavily weighted section is the analysis of the crime scene at 30%. The manager cautions that teams need to be thorough in their analysis explaining not only which pieces of evidence implicate which suspect(s) and why the suspect(s) was (were) chosen as the culprit(s), but also why the other suspects were not chosen.
5. In order to be competitive, each team needs to bring all of the items listed for “students” in the rules. The event manager will provide any other materials or equipment needed to run the tests as listed under “supervisor”.
