

Event Clarifications for  
**PICTURE THIS**

1. On the Complete list of Study Themes, the following subtopics of the highlighted topics will be covered in the Picture This event. These subtopics are: Our Solar System, States of Matter, Meterology, Scientists and their Contributions. (These will be scientists or contributions that are listed on Name the Scientist).
2. Science words from these subtopics will be taken from science books grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> as found per state standards.
3. Teams MUST have 3 team members in order to compete.
4. A white board, 4 markers (black, blue, red, & green) and an eraser will be provided.
5. Each team has 5 minutes. There will be 20 words provided and each team will receive the same words in the same order.
6. Teams will be admitted only one at a time into the testing room and teams from the same school must go back to back.
7. The sketcher may not speak except to indicate a pass, may not give any visual clues, may not use the alphabet or numbers, texting language along with symbols will not be allowed. The sketcher may use spaces to indicate a phrase of more than one word if needed. The sketcher can also utilize the + or - symbols to indicate the word is longer than what has been given. i.e. sun+...because the word in sunshine. (if sun has already been said).
8. If a team violates any of the rules given the team will be penalized that word only.
9. Each team must rotate sketcher when a new term is put into play.
10. Passes are allowed. When a pass occurs, the next sketcher is given the next term. The team may not go back to any passed terms.
11. In the event of a tie, the first tiebreaker will be the fewest passed terms. The second tiebreaker will be the shortest period of time to complete the entire list.
