

# COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINICS

FOR SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY EDUCATORS & SCHOOL PERSONNEL

## BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT:

**QR CODE:** Know your appointment time and group number and have your QR code ready -- either on your phone or printed out. Your QR code will be your “boarding pass” to get you where you need to be at the clinic. Please be punctual and arrive 10 minutes before your appointment time.

**DOCUMENTS:** A photo I.D. - driver’s license or other state-issued identification - is required for check-in. *You will also need the COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card you received at your first appointment.*

**ATTIRE:** Wear appropriate clothing, such as a short-sleeve shirt, that will allow nurses to easily access your upper arm to administer the vaccine. For the safety of visitors and staff, you must wear a face-covering at all times -- even when in your vehicle.

## DURING YOUR APPOINTMENT:

**ARRIVAL:** Upon turning onto Transworld Drive, you will be required to show clinic staff your unique QR code for entry. Staff will then direct you where to park (Please note that if you are too early, you may be redirected until 10 minutes before your appointment time. If you are late, we cannot guarantee your appointment. If your group number has already passed, you may be asked to wait for the next opening.) Once you have parked, **remain in your vehicle until your appointment time.** If you opted-in to receive text messages, you will receive an email and text to alert you when your group number is called.

**CHECK-IN & SCREENING:** When your group number is called, head to the San Joaquin County Office of Education (SJCOE) Wentworth Education Center entrance to check-in. Staff will be available to direct you through the clinic. Please maintain 6 feet of distance from others at all times.

**MONITORING:** The CDC recommends that all people who receive the vaccine be monitored for at least 15 minutes. There will be emergency medical technicians (EMTs) and other healthcare staff at the clinic should you have a reaction to the vaccine.

**CHECK-OUT:** Once you have completed the required 15 to 30 minute observation period, you must check out with a volunteer. When you are cleared to leave, please help keep the line moving by returning directly to your vehicle and following directions to exit the SJCOE campus.

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

**DRIVING & ENTRANCE DIRECTIONS:** All clinics will be held at the SJCOE Wentworth Education Center, 2707 Transworld Drive, Stockton. Visitors must use Qantas Lane to access Transworld Drive. From Arch-Airport Road, turn onto Qantas Lane. Then, turn left onto Transworld Drive. Staff will check you in and provide parking instructions upon entry on Transworld Drive.
