Directions:

- Turn over your paper when prompted by the Event Manager.
- You will have 5-6 minutes to complete this game card. Words must be legible for scoring purposes. During a single round, words may not be repeated.
- The Event Manager will give you a one-minute warning before time is up.
- When time is up, you must stop writing and turn your paper over immediately or risk losing all points for this round.
- Your game card will be scored as follows:

SCORING - Number Correct squared

- one correct term in a row = 1 pt
 - two correct terms in a row = 4 pts.
 - three correct terms in a row = 9 pts.
 - four correct terms in a row = 16 pts.
 - five correct terms in a row = 25 pts.
- one correct term in a column = 1 pt.
 - two correct terms in a column = 4 pts.
 - three correct terms in a column = 9 pts.
 - four correct terms in a column = 16 pts.
 - five correct terms in a column = 25 pts.

Tiebreakers will be determined by the following sequence: i.) Highest individual round score; ii.) Second highest individual round score; iii.) Total columns/rows with 5 correct; iv.) Most columns/rows with 4 correct; v.) Most columns/rows with 3 correct; vi.) Most columns/rows with 2 correct.
