- County representative shared about having more classes in Tracy, having 503 referrals into county programs for 2018/19 and placed 76%. Representative shared about having bootcamps for teachers, professional development and regional trainings, and informed of the new employee updates.

- Valley Mountain Regional Center: There is an upcoming Cultural Fair event that will take place on October 5th, 2019. There was discussion of the need for community collaboration at this event. Melinda volunteered to run a CAC table.
- Family Resource Network: Received another year of the dental grant.
- Department of Rehabilitation: Partnered with Stockton WorkNet to help employ over 100 students over the summer, transitional partnership program with Stockton USD and hoping to partner with County Programs as well, LEAP program geared towards older kids.
- State Council on Developmental Disabilities: The "Get Safe" trainings had great turn outs, received a state-wide grant with Joe Travolta.

CAC Business:

- Melinda got in contact with DREDF regarding a basic training about IEP's.
- Discussion of "Mental Health" as a training title being unappealing and how this can be better advertised.
- Discussion of combining the two mental health trainings if the head count is below 25.
- Discussion of regionalized trainings and have some of the Secondary Transition trainings hosted at other districts and not only in Tracy and Manteca.
- Bylaws update?

- Discussion of moving some trainings to the evenings.
